
The degree programme focuses on providing knowledge for practical use, allowing you to develop business management skills that will enhance your career.

#### Do:

- Write minimum 300 words in your Personal Statement
- Use the Personal Statement guide provided by Admissions
- Address the reasons for applying to the course
- Explain how the course is relevant to your future career, what you will learn, how it is important, and what roles/companies you can work for/expected salary

#### Don't:

- Do not plagiarise your Personal Statement
- Do not give samples to applicants to copy from
- Do not use general information from the internet



## **Compliance Interview**

#### Things to Prepare for Compliance Interview:

- Chosen course and why it interests them
- Reasons for choosing the UK over other countries
- Reasons for choosing ECA & London Met
- Accommodation and travel plans
- Financial situation and how they can afford the course

Candidates must not read from pre-written notes.
