Entry Requirements

Bangladesh	Bachelor's degree when studied for a minimum of four years with grade of 40%; OR a Master's degree following a two or three-year Bachelor's degree
India	Bachelor's degree with pass grade (40% minimum)
Nepal	Completion of a recognised Bachelor degree (when studied for four or more years) Pass Grade
Pakistan	Bachelor's degree (Four year minimum duration) 40% overall; OR Master's degree following a two or three year Bachelor's degree

Statement of Purpose

Do:

- Write minimum 300 words in your Personal Statement
- Use the Personal Statement guide provided by Admissions
- Address the reasons for applying to the course
- Explain how the course is relevant to your future career, what you will learn, how it is important, and what roles/companies you can work for/expected salary

Don't:

- Do not plagiarise your Personal Statement
- Do not give samples to applicants to copy from
- Do not use general information from the internet

Compliance Interview

Things to Prepare for Compliance Interview:

- Chosen course and why it interests them
- Reasons for choosing the UK over other countries
- Reasons for choosing ECA & London Met
- Accommodation and travel plans
- Financial situation and how they can afford the course

Candidates must not read from pre-written notes.
